Trusts Act 2019 commentary

The Trusts Act 2019 comes into force from 30 January 2021. The Trustee Act 1956 will be repealed from 30 January 2021.

Reorganisation of *Law of Trusts* commentary

Most of the previous chapters of *Law of Trusts* have been moved under an “Archive” guidecard as they cover areas of trust law replaced by the Trusts Act 2019.
