Labor to invest \$50 million to upgrade Muswellbrook Hospital

A Foley Labor Government will set aside \$50 million for the long overdue upgrade of Muswellbrook Hospital – without privatising our electricity network.

Labor's \$50 million funding will be for stages two and three of the Muswellbrook Hospital redevelopment.

Stage two (\$20 million) will include:

- Enhanced renal dialysis service;
- Additional chemotherapy chairs;
- · Additional renal dialysis chairs;
- Expanded ambulatory care facilities redeveloping outpatient consulting spaces for medical and surgical services, along with new space for patients recovering from day surgery;
- Upgrading the lift to assist patients;
- Hospital equipment upgrade; and
- Expand the main hospital entrance and reception areas.

Labor will begin planning and set aside \$30 million for stage three of the development expansion which could include:

- Expanded maternity services;
- Additional adult inpatient beds;
- A central sterilising services department;
- Enhanced clinical services such as physiotherapy and pharmacy; and
- More medical consulting rooms.

Labor's \$50 million exceeds the Liberals' existing commitment. Labor will reserve \$30 million more for the hospital redevelopment without selling our electricity network.
